

FREE Residential Electronics Recycling Collection

The Town of Tolland in cooperation with Take 2, Inc. will be hosting a **FREE** Residential Electronics Recycling Collection event at **Tolland High School** located at **1 Eagle Hill**. Residents are encouraged to bring their unwanted electronics to the drive up/drive through electronics collection event on **Saturday, April 27, 2024** between **8 AM and 12 noon**.

Accepted materials include, but are not limited to: Computers, Laptops, Printers, Fax Machines, Monitors, TVs, Cell Phones, Tablets,



Video Games, game consoles, VCR/DVD Machines, Remotes, Keyboards, Small Appliances, Light Bulbs and Batteries. Unaccepted materials include: smoke detectors, propane tanks, ballasts, paint, household hazardous waste and appliances containing freon, i.e. air conditioners, refrigerators, dehumidifiers.

Town Wide Shredding Event

The Town of Tolland will host a **free** paper-shredding event on Saturday, April 27, 2024. The event will take place from 9:00am – 12:00pm at Tolland High School in the rear parking lot. (This event is in conjunction with our Electronics Recycling Event which will be held in the front parking lot.) This event allows residents to bring paper documents for a free and safe paper shredding with proof of residency. Accepted documents will be personal, residential documents only. Commercial or business documents will not be accepted.

- Limit of (3) bags or boxes.
- No junk mail, magazines, books, cards, envelopes, metal ring binders, school papers. Sensitive documents only.
- Non-sensitive documents may be routinely recycled.
- Documents which require shredding should be in secure bags or boxes which can support the weight of the material, be easily accessed within your vehicle for unloading by staff.
- Resident verification (driver's license) required.
- Container(s) or receptacle(s) used to deliver documents to be shredded will not be returned.

64 Cider Mill Road- 350+ acre Town Park containing 3 tennis courts/ 3 pickle ball courts, a basketball court, softball & baseball fields, a swimming pond, bathrooms, 2.5 miles of marked hiking trails and a picnic area.

PAVILION

Is an open air shelter with picnic table seating for groups of up to 75. Facilities include a large charcoal grill, horseshoe pits and a sand volleyball court. Use of a softball field is possible depending on availability. Rental of the Pavilion does not include beach access. Rental by reservation only through the Recreation Office. "THE LODGE"



Collector of Revenue - July is Tax Season!

July is Tax Season!

Notice is hereby given to the taxpayers of the Town of Tolland that the first installment of real estate, personal property, and motor vehicle tax bills on the grand list of October 1, 2023 are due July 1, 2024, payable by August 1, 2024 without penalty.

The last day to pay in person at the Tax Office without interest is Thursday, August 1, 2024 by 7:30 PM. The last day to pay by mail (USPS postmark required) without interest is Thursday, August 1, 2024 or you may use the Town Hall drop box. Payments left in the box after 7:30 PM on Thursday, August 1, 2024 will be late and accrue interest.

Payments can be made online. Your transaction must be completed prior to midnight on August 1, 2024. Visit the Town of Tolland website at www.tollandct.gov, click on Help Center and Pay Taxes Online. ACH payments (electronic checks) are a flat fee of \$1.95 for all bills and credit card payment fees will be 2.99%. Credit card payments are now accepted in the office with a 2.65% fee or a minimum fee of \$3.00

Per State Statute 12-145, interest of 1.5% per month from the due date of July 1 with a minimum charge of \$2.00 is applied to all delinquent bills.

Office hours are: Monday – Wednesday from 8 AM–4:30 PM, Thursday 8 AM–7:30 PM. Town Hall, including the Tax Office, is closed on Friday.

Failure to receive a tax bill will not invalidate the tax or any interest which may, by State law, accrue.

There are a number of tax assessment relief programs authorized by Connecticut State Statute that are available to qualified property owners and renters in Tolland.

Town Assessor's Office - Tax Relief Programs

Town of Tolland Tax Relief Programs

The Tolland Tax Assessor's office is currently accepting applications for tax relief for senior citizens or permanently disabled homeowners from February 1, 2024 through May 15, 2024. There are three separate programs available:

Homeowner Aid for the Elderly and Disabled Program (Circuit Breaker) is a State program which requires homeowners to be 65 years of age as of December 31, 2023, or be 50 years of age or over and the surviving spouse of a homeowner who at the time of death had qualified for and was entitled to tax relief, or be eligible to receive permanent total disability benefits under Social Security. You must also have been a resident of Connecticut for at least one year. Your 2023 income, including Social Security, cannot exceed \$53,400 if married or \$43,800 if unmarried.

Tax Deferral for Senior Citizens (Ordinance 25) is a local tax deferment program. This program defers property taxes for low income or totally disabled homeowners while they own their property. When the property is sold or a use change occurs, all back taxes are due with interest. Your maximum 2023 income cannot exceed \$75,600 for this program. You must be over 65 years of age as of December 31, 2023 or eligible to receive permanent total disability benefits under Social Security.

Local Tax Relief Program for Permanently Disabled and Senior Residents (Ordinance 60) Eligibility requirements are that homeowners must have resided and paid taxes on property since July 1, 2023 or earlier, at least one of the homeowners must be 65 years of age by December 31, 2023 or eligible to receive permanent total disability benefits of the surviving spouse of the homeowner who at the time of death qualified for this program. Total household income for the year 2023 cannot exceed \$75,600 and total household assets (excluding your primary home) cannot exceed \$756,000.

The application period for all three programs is February 1, 2024 through May 15, 2024. All applications must be accompanied with proof of 2023 income. For an application or more information, please call the Tolland Assessor's office at 871-3650.

Tolland Revaluation

The town of Tolland will be conducting a town wide revaluation for the 2024 grand list. Commencing February 2024 the Assessor will be conducting drive by inspections of all properties to review property data and update property photos. Properties that have been sold between October 1, 2023 and September 31, 2024 will be sent sales verification forms. The questionnaire is an essential part of the sale verification process, so please complete these forms and return them to the assessor's office promptly. The sales from this time period will be used to generate values for the entire town. Following the sales analysis, valuation notices will be sent to every property in late fall. Informal hearings will follow for those who wish to review their assessments with the Assessor.

Income and Expense questionnaires will be mailed to all Commercial, Industrial & Apartment type properties as part of the revaluation process in March. This form is due back to the Assessor's office by June 1, 2024. Failure to file in a timely manner will result in a 10% assessment penalty.

June is Dog Licensing Month!



CT law requires that all dogs six months of age or older be licensed during the month of June. The cost is \$8.00 for altered dogs and \$19.00 for unaltered dogs. A one dollar late fee per dog will be charged each month for those who are late.

All dogs must have proof of a current rabies vaccination on file. Postcard reminders will be mailed the last week of May. **Please check the rabies expiration date printed on the postcard. Any dog whose expiration date is 6/1/2024 or before will have to provide a new rabies certificate in order to license in June.** When licensing by mail, make checks payable to "Town of Tolland" and include a self-addressed, stamped envelope for the return of your tags and paperwork. Mail it to: Kathleen Pagan, Town Clerk, 21 Tolland Green, Tolland, CT 06084.

You can also renew your current dog license(s) online using your credit/debit card. There is a \$1.75 convenience fee added to allow for this online service. A valid rabies certificate must already be on file. You will need to enter your dog's current tag number, which is printed on your reminder postcard. Your dog's new tags will be mailed to you.

If you no longer own your licensed dog, please notify us at 860-871-3630 or email us at kpagan@tollandct.gov so that we can remove the record.

Remember: Per CT State Statute, the fine for having an unlicensed dog is \$75.00. *www.tollandct.gov*

A Message from the Town Clerk's Office...

In recent years, you may have heard of property record fraud, and with the increase of personal accounts being hacked, wonder if you could be the target of someone attempting to steal your home and land. Property record fraud is the manipulation of documents related to real estate in order to defraud individuals or institutions. This type of fraud occurs when someone illegally obtains a title to a property or falsifies the records associated with it, without the owner's knowledge or consent. Our office has gotten a few phone calls from concerned residents, asking what they can do to prevent this. While this situation has not occurred to the best of our knowledge here in Tolland, there are safeguards you can do to keep an eye on your records.

You can stop in to the Town Clerk's office anytime during our open business hours. Land records are available on a public terminal in our vault, and we would be happy to show you how to look up your own records.

You can also check your records online from any computer. Go to USlandrecords.com, select Connecticut, then Tolland, and enter your last and first name. When you search, everything in your name will come up and you can view an "unofficial" copy right on the screen, free of charge.

As always, you can call us with any questions – we are here to help. Making a habit of checking on what has been filed in your name periodically is well worth your peace of mind.

The Tolland Housing Rehabilitation Loan Program provides zero percent interest loans to eligible residents for home repair projects that include, but are not limited to: septic systems, well repair, roofing and siding, structural deficiencies, replacement windows, insulation, ADA improvements, plumbing, electrical and heating systems.

To be eligible, yearly gross income must not exceed amounts listed below:

Renter's Rebate

Tolland Human Services will be accepting Renter's Rebate applications beginning **April 1st, 2024.** This income-based program provides a one-time payment to renters based on the rent and utilities paid in **2023.** Recipient or spouse must be 65 years of age or older, or be 50 years of age or older and the surviving spouse of a renter who at the time of the renter's death had qualified and was entitled to tax relief provided such spouse was domiciled with such renter at the time of the renters death, or 18 years of age or older and eligible to receive Social Security Disability benefits and must meet a one year state residency requirement. Proof of income (SSA 1099) and rental expenses for 2023 must be provided.

Building Department 860-871-3601

Did you know that many permits can be applied and paid for online? From the homepage of TollandCT.gov, click on the Building Department, then the Forms & Permits button. While you're on the Building Dept. page, please browse through our many informative handouts. There is quite a bit of information regarding swimming pools, decks, additions and the permit application process in general. Remember to schedule a final inspection appointment to properly close out your permit. Open Building Permits will impede the sale of your home and may give cause to an insurance company to deny a claim for fire or personal injury.

Spring brings many outdoor projects to the forefront. It is likely that you may want to power-wash your home, repair a fence, replace a few shingles, paint the house or stain a deck. While none of the above home-maintenance items require a permit, it is highly recommended that you still hire licensed and insured contractors. You should also always get a written proposal from the contractor and ask for references. Never pay in-full for a job in advance; a partial deposit is common and fair to everyone involved.

Perhaps you are considering adding a tool shed, gazebo or greenhouse to your property? Building and Zoning permits are required for these type of structures larger than 100 square feet. Lots on private septic and wells are required to apply to Eastern Highlands Health Department. Our advice is to call our office to discuss your project and our staff will guide you through the process in an efficient manner.

The Building Official, James Paquin is typically available in the office to answer questions from 8:00-10:00 AM and Noon-2:00 PM, plus 6:00-7:30 PM on Thursdays.



Fire Department & Public Safety

From the Office of the Fire Marshal: Grilling Safety

SAFETY TIPS:

- Propane and charcoal BBQ grills should only be used outdoors
- The grill should be placed well away from the home, deck railings, structures and out from under eaves and overhanging branches
- Keep children and pets at least three feet away from the grill area
- Keep your grill clean by removing grease or fat buildup from the grill and from the trays below the grill
- Never leave your grill unattended
- Always make sure your gas grill lid is open before lighting it

PROPANE GRILLS:

- Check the gas tank hose for leaks before using it for the first time each year. Apply a light soap and water solution to the hose. A propane leak will release bubbles. If your grill has a gas leak, by smell or the soapy bubble test, and there is no flame, turn off both the gas tank and the grill. If the leak stops, get the grill serviced by a professional before using it again. If the leak does not stop, call the fire department. If you smell gas while cooking, immediately get away from the grill and call the fire department. Do not move the grill.
- If the flame **goes out**, turn the grill and gas off and wait at least **5 minutes** before re-lighting it.

CHARCOAL GRILLS:

- There are several ways to get the charcoal ready to use. Charcoal chimney starters allow you to start the charcoal using newspaper as a fuel. If you use a starter fluid, use only charcoal starter fluid. Never add charcoal fluid or any other flammable liquids to the fire.
- Keep charcoal fluid out of the reach of children and



away from heat sources.

- There are also electric charcoal starters, which do not use fire. Be sure to use an extension cord rated specifically for outdoor use.
- When you are finished grilling, let the coals completely cool before disposing in a metal container.

Is Your Street Number Visible from the Road?

Residents and Business Owners are asked to please check their street address numbers. Can they be seen from the road? Are they faded, too small, overgrown or missing? If so, please update your numbers so that they are visible <u>from</u> <u>both directions</u>. The Fire Department offers blue reflective street address signs for \$16. The signs measure 6" wide and 18" long, your house numbers are placed on both sides and the blue coating is also reflective. These signs will make your address easier to find and they also make great gifts! Driveway Accessibility

As you know Tolland Fire Department's number one priority is the safety of our residents and our ability to respond to emergency calls for service. While that statement is true, we are also concerned for the safety of our staff and Fire Department equipment.

Lately, we are noticing a disturbing trend where driveways to properties have become narrow, littered with overhanging trees, limbs, branches and the like. Clearance problems may not be so evident to you, however they are of great concern to the Department.

Since our apparatus is larger than most personal vehicles, extra clearance is needed to accommodate the larger size of a fire truck or ambulance to prevent scratches or damage to the apparatus. Additionally low hanging vegetation could impact your service wires, possibly causing damage to your connection. Low hanging wires may also impede emergency access.

We would appeal to our residents to please evaluate driveway access to their property and complete the necessary maintenance, so that it can easily accommodate larger vehicles. Also, please re-evaluate access often throughout the year, especially after strong storms. Your cooperation will help ensure we can get to you in your time of need safely and quickly, without damaging our equipment or your trees, bushes, etc. Being vigilant will benefit everyone.

Submitted by Tolland C.E.R.T. 40: The Community Emergency Response Team (C.E.R.T.) free training program is a nationally-certified educational series



that focuses on disaster preparedness. Skills such as fire safety, light search and rescue, team organization, and disaster medical operations are among the topics taught during the series. The C.E.R.T. curriculum also teaches valuable skills such as; how to recognize hazards that

are most likely to affect your home, workplace, and neighborhood, steps you can take to prepare for a disaster, identifying and reducing potential fire hazards in your home and what to do when disaster strikes.

Utilizing the training learned in the classroom and during hands-on exercises, C.E.R.T. class participants are welcome to use this knowledge for helping themselves, their families, friends, neighbors and co-workers. While it is not required, graduates who would like to take a more active role in supporting their local emergency response agencies are welcome join their local C.E.R.T. team.

Tolland's C.E.R.T team, known as Tolland C.E.R.T. 40, has been activated for many types of situations including, a land-area search, COVID-19 testing clinics, Tolland Emergency Operation Center operations, Animal Control's rabies vaccination clinic, Celebrate Tolland, and Vernon's July in the Sky. Our team has recently expanded to add HAM radio operators to develop radio communications. Once you've completed all training modules you can choose to join our team. Participants are not required to join the team, but many do!

If there is enough interest, we hope to offer the C.E.R.T training series of classes in 2024.

CT Alert Notification System:

CT Alert is an enrollment based notification system that is

Animal Control - Submitted by Tolland Animal Control: Wildlife Babies



With winter winding down and warm weather on the horizon, residents can expect to see an increase in wildlife throughout town. An increase in wildlife brings the possibility of seeing young and newborn animals. Tolland Animal Control often receives calls for potentially abandoned newborn wildlife during the spring and summer months. We would like to use this opportunity to help inform and educate residents about these youngsters and the best practices for when you encounter them.

If you stumble upon a baby squirrel at the base of a

tree, do not be alarmed. Check the area above and see if there is a visible nest. Squirrels prefer to build their nests high up and it is likely that Mom is nearby. If given some time, she will be able to locate her baby and safely return it to the nest. Be sure to keep people and pets at a safe distance and feel free to contact Animal Control to notify us of your findings. If the baby squirrel appears injured or in significant distress, contact a wildlife rehabilitator or Tolland Animal Control as soon as possible so it can be properly cared for.

Fawns are another common wildlife baby to see as the weather warms up. If you stumble upon a fawn that is by itself, it is best to leave it be and keep a safe distance. It is typical for its mother to return at different times during the day to feed it. If a fawn has been in the same spot for an extended period of time, and you are concerned that it may be orphaned, contact Tolland Animal Control and provide us details such as how long it has been there, if you have seen any other deer in the area etc. We can provide instructions and assistance on the next steps that should be taken.

In addition to fawns and squirrels, you may find baby bunnies. If you find baby bunnies that are alone, as with our other warm weather newborns, be sure to keep people and pets at a distance. Their mother will only visit a few times a day in order to avoid attracting predators. It may be more common for the mother to spend time with her babies during the overnight hours.
